Global Content

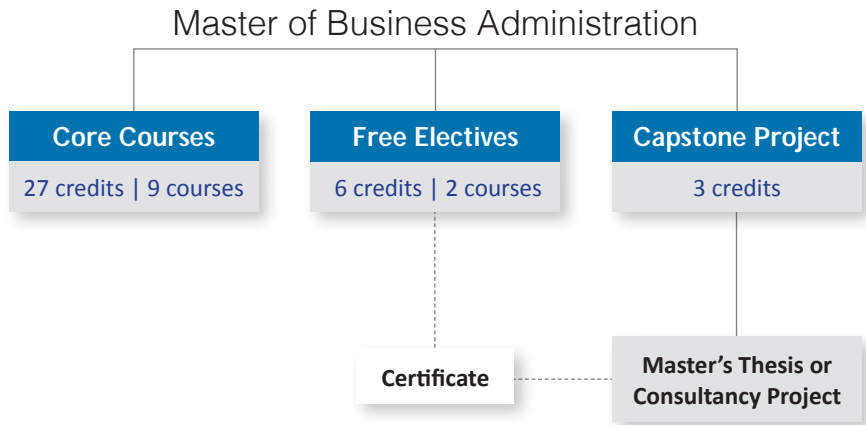
