- The degree requires a total of 121 credits, so if you transfer the maximum number of credits (90), you could earn your Bachelor's degree in less than two years.
- Both need-based financial aid and merit-based scholarships are available.
- The BSBA completion is open to students at our Nashua, New Hampshire campus, offering both online and in-person options for maximum flexibility.
- Tuition fees are comparable to in-state tuition at a community college.
