OVERVIEW

Each year we welcome individual college/university students for a semester of study. Students are free to take any of the undergraduate General Education courses, and any core or elective degree course at their level of study provided they meet the course pre-requisites.

"Athens Across the Ages" is our most popular study abroad experiential course. This course explores Athens from its ancient origins as a small village at the foot of the Acropolis, first settled in 4500 BC, to modern times, where it became the sprawling capital of Greece and home to five million people. Class meetings and on-site lectures are organized chronologically and arranged to acquaint the student with significant historical events.
